What is it?

The Pipeline to Pacific assists San Joaquin Delta College (SJDC) students in completing introductory coursework and transfer to the Bachelor of Science in Computer Science degree program at Pacific while using their time and money efficiently. Acceptance into the Computer Science Pipeline program and completion of the requirements below guarantee the student’s admission into Pacific’s Computer Science degree program, it does not guarantee a timeline in which the degree will be completed.

What do I get?

- Counseling and student support services at SJDC
- Course-to-course articulation so you know how your courses transfer to Pacific
- Annual course advisement with Pacific faculty
- An individualized, detailed academic plan while at SJDC that takes pre-reqs and course requirements into consideration for future coursework at Pacific
- Access to the Pacific library via a Guest Card (see application on the back)
- Clubs at Pacific

What is required?

Students in the Pipeline to Pacific are guaranteed admission to Pacific’s BS in Computer Science program upon satisfactory completion of:

- MATH 001 at SJDC with a “C” or better
- CSP 026A or CSP 031A at SJDC with a “C” or better
- CSP 026B or CSP 031B at SJDC with a “C” or better
- Transfer admission application
- Minimum 2.75 GPA

PacificCard™ TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

Card Use: The PacificCard™ is your campus ID guest card which must be presented to enter campus facilities. You are responsible for any usage of your card. Your card may be confiscated if presented by someone else for any use.

Lost, Stolen Cards and Replacement Fees: You shall immediately report any lost or stolen PacificCard™. You may report the loss and immediately suspend your card in person at the PacificCard™ during office hours, or by phone at (209) 946-CARD. Regular academic session office hours are Monday thru Friday, 8:30am - 4:30pm. Card suspension requests are also taken 24 hours a day 7 days a week at the Public Safety Office or by phone at (209) 946-2537. You are responsible for all card transactions. There is no charge to suspend your card or to reactivate it if recovered. A PacificCard™ that is damaged or defaced is no longer valid and must be replaced. A \$25 fee is charged to replace a lost/stolen card. A damaged or defaced card is replaced for a \$5 fee. **If receiving a replacement card, previous cards must be surrendered to the card office and be destroyed – no exceptions.**
